U.S. Citizen; Minimum age of 18; Valid Driver's license; good physical condition; eligibility for Wisconsin Law Enforcement Standards Board Certification; High school diploma; Associate degree-Criminal Justice or related field or a minimum of 60 fully accredited college level credits; ability to possess a firearm; no felony convictions; no domestic abuse convictions; Vision correctable to 20/20; good verbal and written communication skills; react quickly and effectively to stressful situations; able to work evenings, weekends and holidays; knowledge and skills in operating computer systems; clear and concise speech; as well as the ability to use all standard law enforcement equipment.
