e. **Old Business:**


1. WISCOM: We had a \$645,000 Homeland Security grant. For the most part all is completed. There are a couple of things that still need to be done. A new tower was put up in Plymouth Township (South Tower) and the old one is taken down and will be put up in Cutler Township. This is in-process of being done. We are waiting on FCC permits, etc. There was a State Audit and we passed. The last grant neglected Public Works departments so the current grant has them included. Those that did not request radios in the first round have now done so. The total of the grant that Gervase just put in for totals \$267,000. There are 7 counties that are able to apply with Juneau County being one.
2. Code Red: Is up and running and seems to be working well. Gervase did a test call and it worked. Charlyn also did a test call that worked with her number, as well as receiving a warning call to her address over CodeRed per text message.
3. Germantown Tabletop Grant: The final design meeting is 12/17/14. This tabletop is facilitated by the State. The tabletop exercise is scheduled for January 22, 2015.
4. Marquis Energy Exercise: This was held on October 30th regarding loading/unloading anhydrous ammonia. Marquis a little apprehensive at doing the exercise at first but the exercise went well and they were quite pleased. Level A Hazmat Team member was there, as well as Necedah Fire Department, American Red Cross-Kris Yager and Marquis Energy Administration.

f. **New Business:**

1. Hazmat Team Report: Bruce Holsclaw: No new items. Team is struggling to recruit new members.
2. JCPPP Report: Barb Theis: The last meeting of the JCPPP was a productive meeting with heavy representative of law enforcement attending speaking about a county-wide school safety plan. There was a presentation on ALICE program. With a program as such, law enforcement and first responders would know that all schools would have similar plans and it would be more productive to know going to such a call what to expect. Was an excellent meeting. All except one was interested in a county-wide plan. The one has their own plan.
