

Juneau County Senior Nutrition Program

The purpose of this program is to provide nutritious, well balanced meals along with fellowship and fun for our senior residents. Meals are planned by a Registered Dietitian and comply with Federal, State and Local regulations for the Title III meal program. Monthly menus are published in the Ageless newsletter and are announced daily over radio station WRJC.

ELIGIBILITY

- Age 60 or over.
- Disabled in Elderly Housing where Title III meals are served on site.
- Disabled living with elderly person that comes to congregate dining center.
- Spouse of eligible participant.
- Volunteer with the nutrition program.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All Participants are to be treated equally and fairly, and with respect. Smoking, alcohol and the use of illegal drugs are prohibited. Aggressive language and/or behavior will not be tolerated. Maintenance of personal hygiene and appropriate attire is expected of all participants.

REGISTRATION

Participants are asked to complete a Client Intake Form on their initial visit and then annually thereafter. This information will remain confidential and is necessary for the continuation of funding for this program through federal and state governments.

HOME DELIVERED MEALS

Home delivered meals are also served from all dining centers. These meals require an order from the participants' physician. Frozen meals are available for those who need them on weekends and holidays.
