April 9, 2019 at 8:30 am

Meeting was called to order by Jerry Niles

Motion by Willard, seconded by Feldman to approve March 2019 minutes

Motion by Feldman, seconded by Willard to approve March 2019 vouchers

- March OT – Traffic is down from the same time last year. Dispatch is up from last year due to open positions, training and two unfilled part time dispatch positions, however, 10k has been saved in the two open position scheduled wages. The detective payroll is below last year. Jail is up due to comp time being taken and a deputy being on light duty. See below.

- Upham Woods – The Stewards of the Dells met with the President of the Board of Regents last week. They were requesting a canoe/kayak put in on County Rd N. A response was promised by the Board of Regents soon. Also, it sounds like the UW Police will be taking over enforcement of issues at Camp Upham Woods, including trespassing issues at Blackhawk Island. This is decided to the UW as long as it is used for training purposes, however, trespassing issues have them concerned that they will lose access to the island.
- Mauston Fire ATV – the MFD ATV was used to help locate a subject that had hidden in a swampy area, the tracked vehicle had gotten stuck and was towed. During the tow, the vehicle was damaged to the unusable point. Their insurance is going to pay for the ATV, however, there is a \$1k deductible. Per state statute, we are required to cover costs incurred by assisting agencies. Motion made by Willard and seconded by Feldman to pay the deductible from the Mutual Aide Fund. If there are not enough funds available, money to come from the Equipment Repair and Maintenance Fund.
- Other new business
- Update on the drug court/jail drug treatment/multi county – Adams, Juneau, Marquette drug initiative. There is a grant due in mid June for anywhere between 600k and 1.5m to start a drug treatment program in jail. These funds would be used to have a treatment coordinator and one or two assistants, along with the appropriate DHS follow-up after release.
- Boat Patrol – We are working on 5 new hires for summer park, boat and ATV patrol.

Motion made by Willard and seconded by Feldman to adjourn the meeting.
