May 14, 2019 at 8:30 am

Meeting was called to order by Jerry Niles

Motion by Willard, seconded by Feldman to approve April 2019 minutes

- Dispatch – Motion made by Willard and seconded by Feldman to fill the vacant dispatch position
- Captain – We have been without a patrol captain since 2014. We had added a road lieutenant position to balance the workload. There will be an increase to the budget of \$1100 yearly, so \$500-\$600 for the remainder of the year. There will be interviews for one of the two open lieutenant positions (one patrol and one jail) on Thursday and the intent is to name the new LT next week and then post the captain position and hire for the vacant lieutenant position after the captain position if hired from within. Motion made by Feldman and seconded by Willard to hire for the road captain position and eliminate one of the three road lieutenant positions.
- Other new business
- Radios – we will begin testing soon
- Boat Patrol – Mueller will start the boat patrol schedule next Monday
- Upham Woods – Captain Pleutsch (sp) from the UW Police went to the Highway Department committee meeting and brought some proposed changes to County Rd N in front of Upham Woods, starting with a request to the Highway Department to do a speed study by Upham Woods. Further discussion may include speed bumps, school speed zone designation, additional lighting and new reflective crosswalks.
