1. Meeting called to order by chair, Joe Lally, at 7:56 am.
2. MINUTES
Motion by Zindorf seconded by Seamans to approve the minutes of June 13th, 2019 meeting. Motion carried.
3. VOUCHERS
Motion by Wilhorn, seconded by Raese. Motion carried
4. NRCS- Jon Field
 - *Juneau County has 44 CSP applications, most of the field visits have been completed
 - * A pasture walk was held on Paradise Found Farms on June 19th
 - *10 applications have been funded for EQIP
5. FSA – Jim Raese
 - *Crop Reporting deadline is being extended by one week to July 22nd
 - * Dairy producers that are still milking are slowly signing up for the DMC program
 - *Still no details on the Market Facilitation Program for 2019
 - *A new PT has been selected, waiting for the background check to be completed
6. MULTI-COUNTY GROUNDWATER UPDATE – Dustin Ladd
 - *A meeting was held on June 24th, 5 county board members attended
 - *A decision was made to create 2 groups a technician's workgroup and an outreach workgroup
 - *The next meeting will be held July 29th in Adams

7. JUNE WATER TESTING PROGRAM – Dustin Ladd
 - *Over 300 nitrate samples were tested
 - *10% of the samples taken tested over 10 ppm
 - * Another nitrate testing program will be held during the Juneau County Fair
8. VAN REPLACEMENT -Dustin Ladd
 - *Discussion on repair or replacement of Land & Water van
 - *Motion by Zindorf, seconded by Lally for Dustin Ladd to begin replacement process. Motion carried
9. MOU WITH USGS & LAKE REDSTONE PROTECTION DISTRICT-Dustin Ladd
 - * Stream gage equipment will be installed in 3 locations on the North end of the lake
 - *The equipment will measure sediment loading into and out of the lake and will assist with the Lake Redstone 9 Key Element Plan
 - *USGS has offered a 50% cost share, Juneau and Sauk county along with the Lake Redstone Protection district will cover the remaining 50%
 - *Motion by Wilhorn, seconded by Zindorf to approve Dustin Ladd signing the MOU. Motion carried
10. DUFFY ROAD PROJECT– Dustin Ladd
 - *The DNR worked two weeks to complete the scheduled construction for the projects first year
 - *Future work at the site includes dredging, brush removal, and removal of a pond
11. MANURE STORAGE ORDINANCE UPDATE- Brian Goepfert
 - *Brian Goepfert is in the process of updating the Juneau County manure storage ordinance
 - *The old standards are outdated and there are new standards to include such as NR151
 - *Discussed manure overflow problems in Juneau County
