

Juneau County Sheriff's Committee Meeting Minutes

August 13, 2019 at 8:30 am

Meeting was called to order by Jerry Niles

Motion by Feldman, seconded by Willard to approve July 2019 minutes

Motion by Willard, seconded by Feldman to approve July 2019 vouchers

- July OT – There is 32% of the budget left for the jail, the detectives division is considerably better than 2018 at this time. Dispatch is up due to personnel changes and needing to fill shifts, as it patrol. There will be money reimbursed for some overtime for contracted events and services such as Lyndon Park Fest, Ho-Chunk patrol and upcoming Los Dells Festival.
- Crystal Reports – Motion made by Willard and seconded by Feldman to approve the purchase of three Crystal Reports Licenses with funds to come from the Sheriff's Office Paper Service Revenue Account.
- ATV – This agenda item is tabled until the September meeting
- Large Assembly Application – Motion made by Feldman and seconded by Willard to approve the large assembly application for Woodside Ranch for Los Dells Festival
- City of Mauston Mutual Assistance – We received a letter from Morrison Sund PLLC in regards to the March 29th insurance claim by the City of Mauston for the property damage sustained to their John Deere Gator requesting payment of \$35,326.11 within 30 days or they will file suit. No action at this point. The letter was turned over to Attorney Lasker
- Body Cameras – There will be a request for approximately \$2250 for (5) three year software licenses for our existing body cameras. No action at this time until we receive a written quote from Provision.
- Motion made by Feldman and seconded by Willard to approve the purchase of three training pistols from Kiesler Police Supply at a cost of \$1392
- Transport Van – It was previously approved by the committee to use \$9000 from the revolving vehicle account to purchase a used transport van. After an exhaustive search for a van meeting this criteria in the specified price range, Captain Pedersen asked that we take \$20000 from the inmate canteen fund instead to purchase a van. Motion made by Willard and seconded by Feldman
