1. Meeting called to order by chair, Joe Lally, at 8:00 am
2. MINUTES
Motion by Seamans seconded by Raese to approve the minutes of August 8th, 2019 meeting. Motion carried
3. VOUCHERS
Motion by Zindorf, seconded by Wilhorn. Motion carried
4. NRCS- Jon Field
 - Field mentioned that Juneau County has a new Water Management Specialist by the name of Jeff Schure, who works out of the Fitchburg Service Center in Fitchburg, WI.
 - Jon mentioned that they are currently finishing up a grazing project and have potentially three dam projects to finish up yet this fall.
 - Jon mentioned that NRCS is currently paying out EQIP cost-share payments for 2,700 acres of cover crops.
 - Jon mentioned that NRCS is currently making cost-share payments for 2019 CSP contracts. There could be a new CSP sign-up this December.
5. FSA – Jim Raese
 - Raese mentioned that FSA is currently making 2019 CRP, 2018 ARC and PLC payments. Staff is currently making MFP appointments.
6. WILDLIFE DAMAGE ABATEMENT PROGRAM-Phil Peterson
 - Tabled until November meeting

7. INTERGOVERNMENTAL RESOLUTION FOR TRM GRANTS-Dustin Ladd

- Ladd requested that the committee approve an intergovernmental resolution for future TRM grants and permission to take it to the full county board for approval.
- Motion by Wilhorn, Seconded by Zindorf, Motion carried

8. UPDATED JFA BETWEEN USGS-Dustin Ladd

- Ladd requested that the committee approve an updated JFA between USGS.
- Motion by Seamans, Second by Wilhorn, Motion carried

9. MANURE STORAGE ORDINANCE-Dustin Ladd

- Ladd mentioned that an overtopping manure storage structure has been reported to the DNR for further action. An enforcement meeting has been scheduled with the landowner, LWRD, and the DNR in November.
- Ladd requested that the committee schedule a public meeting for the revised Juneau County Animal Waste Storage Ordinance. It was decided that the public hearing would be held right after the regular monthly committee meeting in November at the courthouse.

10. DNR STREAM MEETING-Dustin Ladd

- Ladd mentioned that the LWRD held a joint meeting with SC DNR fisheries staff, Paul Krahn, and Duke Welter to discuss a 2020 preliminary plan for fisheries work and funding within Juneau County.

11. CONSTRUCTION UPDATE-Brian Goepfert

- In addition to the project that Field mentioned in his report, Goepfert mentioned that LWRD should wrap up three projects this fall, including a manure storage closure, a prescribed grazing plan, and a grade stabilization repair.
- Goepfert also mentioned that the department is in the process of giving away or carrying over any SWCD bond funds that have not been spent for 2019.

12. CWD STATION/DEER DUMPSTER-Dustin Ladd

- Ladd mentioned that the LWRD is hosting a deer dumpster at the fairgrounds and that Outdoors Forever is covering the cost of the dumpster. LWRD will receive 50% reimbursement from the DNR for hosting a dumpster.
- Ladd asked the committee for permission for the LWRD to participate and host a CWD Station and Kiosk.
