

INDUSTRIAL AND RECREATION COMMITTEE Minutes

Present were Ray Feldman, Jack Jasinski and James Parrett. The meeting was called to order at 11:00 a.m. by Ray. Motion to approve the minutes of February 8, 2022 meeting was made by Jack, seconded by Jim, and approved unanimously.

Discussed the ongoing lawsuit involving Central Sands Dairy and Wysocki Farms in northern Juneau County.

Jim Parrett discussed the Finance Committee meetings of February 23 and March 7. LaValle Coop received \$400,000 grant and Lynxx received \$500,000 to continue broadband expansion. The Parks and Forestry request was cut in half for Castle Rock county park updates. The American Rescue Plan funds were granted \$910,000 to the cable companies so far. Jack Jasinski heard about the 1200 acre solar farm proposed for southern Juneau County also. Discussion.

The location for a Union Center canoe/kayak landing probably will be at American Legion 19 acre site, was next discussed.

The discussion next was about a spring familiarization tour of the county. Probably this would be after the May meeting.

Jim Parrett made a motion to adjourn.
