Under new developments the plaintiff's attorney's letter in case of Adamek, et al. v Central Sands Dairy, LLC et al. 18CV220 stating that defendants had produced over 2 million pages of documents about farm practices and tests was discussed.

Opening of the Elroy to Sparta portion of the bike trail and Senator Marklein's effort to get the DNR, Dept. of Tourism and Office for Outdoor Recreation to publicize the event was discussed next. Elroy's big event next is the Apple Dunking weekend September 14.

The donation of the American Legion 19 acre tract for a kayak launch on the Baraboo River was voted on today by Parks and Forestry Committee. Jack said he did not see much action at Beyond Boundaries in Wonewoc yet this spring.

A possible Familiarization Tour by County Board members after the June 21 meeting touring the southeastern quarter of the county was discussed next.
