Discussed PFAS in Necedah water supply.

Discussed the closing of Central Sands Dairy. Ray reported DNR has to supervise manure clean out in spring.

Union Center canoe landing – Jack asked if existing driveway off Highway 80, 82 & 33 is still useable to develop the canoe landing.

Necedah Refuge roads – Jack says Necedah Town road in good shape. But west side of Refuge roads have cuts where ditches cross town roads to prevent through traffic. Jack says Cutler town responsible for west side roads.
