

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT FOR
COUNTY HH RECONDITION PROJECT
FROM SOUTH COUNTY LINE TO COUNTY J, JUNEAU COUNTY**

In the interest of protecting the health and safety of the community to prevent the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19), Juneau County will host an online public involvement period for an explanation of proposed improvements to the County HH recondition project that extends from the south county line to the southern County J intersection in the town of Lyndon. The project, currently being designed by the engineering consulting firm of MSA Professional Services, Inc. (MSA) in conjunction with the county and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, is currently planned for 2022 construction.

The public involvement period will be held online on the Juneau County Highway & Public Works website located at <http://www.co.juneau.wi.gov/highway--public-works2.html> from May 8 to May 29, 2020. An informative project handout and project exhibits are available for viewing. The public is encouraged to review the project materials and provide comments on the proposed design.

The project will recondition County HH, replacing the existing deteriorated pavement within the project limits. The proposed improvement also includes two reconstruction areas, the first near the Dore Road intersection to upgrade the substandard horizontal curve and intersection angle, and the second located just south of Delmore Road to upgrade the substandard vertical curve. Two small drainage structures will be replaced near the south end of the project. There will be strips of right of way needed at several locations, and temporary easements to blend slopes. County HH will be closed to through traffic during construction with access to adjacent properties during construction.
