**ACCESS TO HEALTHY,
AFFORDABLE FOOD**

People felt the price of food in the county is determined by one grocery store and prices are high because there is no competition.

MENTAL HEALTH ACCESS

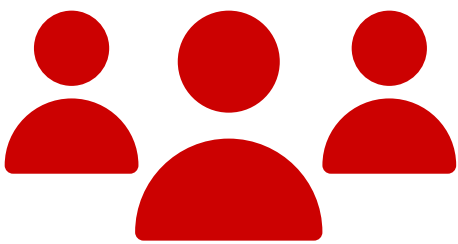
Stigma pertaining to mental health is a key barrier to people getting support. Both physical and financial access and availability of mental health services and resources are top priorities.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Affordability and quality of housing are top concerns. Participants felt people were sacrificing transportation, their children's needs, housing location, and food in order to get quality housing within their budget.

GOOD JOBS & STRONG ECONOMY

Transportation and childcare availability are large barriers for resident's ability to access jobs in Juneau County. The jobs that are available may not pay enough to overcome housing, transportation, and childcare costs.
