Approval of Minutes

CST/CCS Unit Presentation

Danielle Moore, Supervisor, and staff attend. Danielle provides a handout overview of responsibilities and their various roles they provide for their consumers. In 2019, CCS has served 92 individuals and have successfully discharged 37. Their goal by the end of the year is to eliminate the consumer waitlist. Some setbacks include a lack of in-house therapists, male workers, and mentors. They do hope to fill 2 more LTE positions and the Board approved another full time CCS Facilitator position for 2020. CST services kids under 18; unless on an IEP, then they can stay on caseload until age 21. To qualify for the CST program, the youth needs to be enrolled in two "systems of care" such as having an IEP or be involved with the Youth Justice program. There has been higher enrollment due to community having more knowledge of the program and hearing success stories.

Request to fill Child Support Specialist Position

Internal employee took Lead position leaving another position open. Informational since full County Board has already approved.

Increase Corp Counsel Assistant hours

Informational, full county board has already approved position to increase up to 32 hours/week.

Other Business

WCHSA Board Member Event. Tim Cottingham discusses conference. Dawn is attending December 4th and 5th conference in Rothschild.

2020 Budget Update. Approved by County Board on November 5th. Dawn discusses approval of new hires throughout DHS.

CLTS/CCOP Advisory Committee update. No updates from Dawn and Carrie is absent.

Billing update- JoAnn and Alison have been working closely with our billing department to build more events in our MyEvolv (electronic records) system to bill insurance and be reimbursed.

General – Drug Court Grant discussion on possible hire for Drug Court Coordinator. Sheriff's Department received grant to hire their own therapist and case manager for inmates.

Kelly, Corie, Peg, David, and Dawn met with the judges and Register of Probate to discuss court and county working together to meet needs of citizens. New things to try to speed up and streamline the process.




