

Juneau County Sheriff's Committee Meeting Minutes

February 11, 2020 at 8:30 am

Present: Lynn Willard, Ray Feldman, Brent Oleson, Andy Zobel, Gary Pedersen, Colleen Beier and Elizabeth Geesaman

Meeting was called to order by Lynn Willard

Motion by Feldman, seconded by Willard to approve January 2020 minutes

Motion by Feldman, seconded by Willard to approve January 2020 vouchers

- The final numbers from the 2019 budget sheet were provided to review spending
- Humane Officer/Dog Catcher – Kevin Luedtke will continue to be responsible as the Humane Officer, he will be relinquishing the dog catcher duties. Attorney Lasker is approving job descriptions for both the humane officer and the dog catcher positions. Motion made by Feldman and seconded by Willard to approve the job descriptions as approved by Attorney Lasker.
- Motion was made by Feldman and seconded by Willard to approve donations to the Green Lake County Humane Society, Chasing Daylight and the Sauk County Humane Society in the amounts of \$1000, \$1000 and \$500 respectively for animals taken in by them in 2019 which saved the county a total of \$34,328.60. Funds to come from the dog license fee fund.
- Drone – request to purchase a drone which can be used in homes etc for the tactical team to use during search warrants at an approximate cost of \$499. Motion made by Feldman and seconded by Willard to purchase drone with funds from the tactical team budget
- Radio System – there are lights out on the northern tower in addition to the tower being at 100% weight capacity. Motion made by Willard and seconded by Feldman to approve the replacement of the light and to remove unnecessary and unused equipment from the northern tower with funds to come from the tower budget
- Taser Cartridges – Motion made by Willard and seconded by Feldman to approve the purchase taser cartridges at an approximate cost of \$2700 for annual training with funds to come from the jail inmate account
- Jail summer intern – We will be having a summer intern from approximately June 1st through mid-August. Informational only
- Wisconsin Surplus – Motion made by Feldman and seconded by Willard to sell surplus printer cartridges on the Wisconsin Surplus Auction website.
- Duty Ammo – Motion made by Willard and seconded by Feldman to approve the purchase of duty ammunition at an approximate cost of \$643 to come from the ammunition budget
- Evidence Room Fan – There is a law enforcement grant for \$5000 to cover a new evidence room fan with the costs to be reimbursed to the county after initial payment. Motion made by Feldman and seconded by Willard

Motion made by Willard and seconded by Feldman to adjourn the meeting.
