Jack Jaskinski -Marathon Gas Mauston now going ahead putting in new truck stop convenience store - building activity underway. Jack wanted to know about Clean Beam & how their product was selling and how product development was going.

New boat launch on 4 Rivers Rivers. Tie in American Recovery Act

Baraboo River - Union Center - need for money to develop new location for canoe/kayak landing.

Ray talked about Stewards of the Dells trying to locate a new canoe/kayak landing site upstream of Camp Upham Woods on the Wis. River and improvements needed for boat landings on the Lemonweir River.

Jack Jasinski talked about possibly locating a canoe/kayak landing on the Yellow river downstream of 9th Avenue where present canoe/kayak is located to provide a trip downstream of 9th Avenue toward Necedah. Jack to look into land to use for new canoe/kayak landing closer to Necedah.

Discussed using 501(c)3 charitable organization to use funds to develop boat landings on the four rivers and tourism enhancement places for American Recovery Act funds.
