

## **INDUSTRIAL AND RECREATION COMMITTEE Minutes**

**July 13, 2021**

Meeting called to order by Chairman Feldman at 11:00 a.m. In attendance was committee member Jack Jasinski. The minutes from June 8 meeting were approved.

Jack tried to call Bill Murphy who owns the land on the Yellow River about three miles upstream of Necedah but could not make contact.

Jack asked if repairs were done to Elroy-Sparta bike trail. Ray reported that he could not find out but that UW Extension report shows \$900,000 economic impact to county of bikers. Verso-paper mill closing at Wisconsin Rapids and state discussion to fund coop to buy mill to keep open discussed. Jack moved and Ray seconded approving county resolution for state to fund passed. American Rescue Plan and county meeting August 9<sup>th</sup> was discussed and whether Baraboo Recreation Plan could be part of County Outdoor Plan 2018 floods along Baraboo River and FEMA reimbursement discussed. Roads around Necedah WLR discussed and Jack reported on Necedah Town efforts. Central Sands Dairy lawsuit next is August 27, 2021 at 10:00. Scheduling conference is next for lawsuit action.
