Discussed roads closed around Necedah Wildlife Refuge. Cutler and Kingston Township, 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue North and 4<sup>th</sup> Street West are closed due to high water and lack of funding by towns.

Update on new developments – Discussion of empty Kmart and Shopko buildings. Why can't we find a store like Theisens or Tractor Supply or a clothing store?

Discussed ATV traffic increasing in the Northern parts of Juneau County. Possible ATV camp sites at Wilderness Park to accommodate toy haulers.

Familiarization trip discussion – Trip was quite educational. Tour of harvesting cranberries. Highway Department garage in Necedah has an addition waiting to be built but construction is waiting on materials.

Ambulance services/rescue squad discussion of various townships. There is a reduction in available ambulance services.
