1. Meeting called to order by chair, Rodney Seamans, at 8:20 am
2. MINUTES

3. VOUCHERS – Dustin Ladd
 - Update given on producer-led, well closure and access roads projects payments sent out in December.
4. APHIS – Phil Peterson
 - Update on a claim for Deer Damage Program
 - *Motion by Rodney, seconded by Lally to approve deer damage claim. Motion Carried.
 - Discussion of venison donation program, wildlife complaints, and deterrents
